Your actions of serving and giving made it possible for us to Reach Out and touch the lives of children and their families around the world and right here at home with food, water, medical care, shelter and much-needed relief supplies.

In 2015, ISOH/IMPACT & partners distributed 186 shipments locally, nationally and internationally worth an estimated \$6 million throughout the United States and 17 countries.

ISOH/IMPACT assisted families in Appalachia, North & South Carolina and Texas with food and relief aid.

More than 500 families now have safe drinking water in Haiti, Honduras thanks to new purification systems.

The [Bucket Brigade](#) and the [Kids Against Hunger](#) reached out and distributed more than 5 million servings of food to hungry families in Northwest Ohio, across the United States and 17 other countries.

The LightHouse provided shelter, medical care and education to four children & one adult.

The Keeping Kids Kozy and Warm community outreach helped provide more than 300 local families with the basic essentials over the holiday season and throughout the winter months.
